Position Summary:

This position plays a key leadership role in the planning and service delivery of Groundside transportation, parking, curb management and associated construction activities. The incumbent leads a team of two Managers, including a Manager, Parking Operation and a Manager, Ground Transportation Services. Accountable to monitor, measure, analyze and report on the delivery of ground transportation and parking operations that affect service delivery and operational efficiency.

As Associate Director, Groundside Operations, you will:

- Develop and implement effective solutions to improve and ensure the sustainability of the parking facilities and groundside initiatives including performance, experience, reliability, passenger communication, wayfinding, conformance to regulatory and corporate standards and readiness of all groundside processes/programs
- Accountable for the Groundside plan of operations, curbside, roadway and parking enforcement, irregular
 Operations (IRROPS) plans, operational contingencies, business continuity and construction mitigation plan
- Coordinate and communicate groundside activities to the GTAA and community while minimizing impact to our passengers
- Monitor, analyze and report on performance KPI's for Groundside Operation activities around service delivery and operational efficiency
- Identify patterns, areas of opportunities and gaps in service delivery and provide sound corrective actions
- Coordinate and approve construction activity to manage and minimize impacts for garages, parking lots and curbside
- Prepare plans, Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's) and contingencies for the service delivery team
- Liaise with the Director, Terminal Operations to make decisions for operational activities and set strategic goals
- Provide input into strategic operational decisions such as technologies, long-term labour and equipment, facility location decisions, and long-term capacity to meet our internal/external customers' requirements
- Follow up with business partners, contractors, and project management with regards to service failures
- Responsible for high level decision making, building long-term initiatives, and coordinating with our business team.
- Responsible for conflict resolution from customers and passengers
- Audit the service delivery component against the plan
- Develop and maintain strong relationships with customers and partners to drive operational performance, influence behaviour and remove impediments to improve the passenger experience
- Provide effective and inspiring leadership while creating an environment of accountability become part or the norm by measuring the outcome
- Overall management of contracts, including the renewal process (RFP, evaluation, and award); establishment of
 performance standards and Service Level Agreements (SLA); reporting on performance standards and SLA; and
 control of the contract budget
- Accountable for invoice processing, supply requisitioning, and budget oversight for all contracts
- Prepare and manage annual budget; including headcounts, OPEX and CAPEX programs and initiatives
- Coach, mentor and individuals and teams to rise to their full potential while providing timely, constructive and consistent feedback and personal development opportunities
